FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

October 2018

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **72** calls for service; **48** incidents were for emergency medical and **24** incidents were suppression-related. **11** of the medical calls were BLS while **32** were ALS and **5** didn't require medical care. Station 36 responded to **36** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **3** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **11** calls within the Southeast Area and **8** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **91** calls.
