FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

March 2017

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **85** calls for service; **65** incidents were for emergency medical and **20** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **33** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **5** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **11** calls within the Southeast Area and **7** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **108** calls.

Calls of Interest:

March 7th -A36 was dispatched into Barrington for a traffic accident, where they transported 1 person to the hospital. This incident involved a semi-truck fire and escalated into a hazmat incident that kept portions of Rt. 14 closed for several days.

March 17th -E36 was dispatched for wires down at Guthrie & Dundee. A truck had hit a power pole and there were wires down across the road. Dundee Road was closed for several hours.

March 21st -E36 and 702 responded into Hoffman Estates for a structure fire. E36 arrived in staging and was put on deck near command. 702 (A/C Mohr) was assigned as RIT Chief.

March 25th -A36 was dispatched on the box alarm to Lake Zurich. A36 was assigned to the rehabilitation division.

March 25th -A36 responded into Hoffman Estates on a structure fire. A36 was assigned to the rapid intervention team.
